Total enrolment fees for 2016-2017 Fall and Spring academic terms are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Faculty of <b>Dentistry</b> → 60 000,00 TL</li> <li>• Faculty of <b>Medicine</b> → 55 000,00 TL</li> <li>• Faculty of <b>Pharmacy</b> → 45 000,00 TL</li> <li>• Faculty of <b>Law</b> → 44 000,00 TL</li> <li>• Faculty of <b>Engineering</b> Faculty of <b>Architecture</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Department of <b>Architecture</b> → 35 000,00 TL</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Faculty of <b>Art and Sciences</b> Faculty of <b>Economics and Administrative Sciences</b> Faculty of <b>Communication</b> Faculty of <b>Architecture</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Department of <b>Industrial Design</b></li> <li>• Department of <b>Interior Design</b></li> </ul> </li> <li>Faculty of <b>Economics</b> English Preparatory School</li> <li>• Faculty of <b>Fine Arts</b> → 28 000,00 TL</li> <li>• Faculty of <b>Health Sciences</b> Faculty of <b>Education</b> → 25 000,00 TL</li> <li>• School of <b>Applied Sciences</b> → 22 000,00 TL</li> </ul> <p>VAT is not included.</p> <p>Graduates of <b>İSTEK</b> Foundation who received a minimum of three (3) years of education at high-school level, or five (5) years of education at primary and secondary school level, earn the following rights on the condition that they are placed to Yeditepe University within their first five preferences.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>25%</b> tuition fee discount for those placed with pay quota</li> </ul> <p>Among these students:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>50%</b> tuition fee discount for those placed with 25% scholarship quota,</li> <li>• <b>75%</b> tuition fee discount for those placed with 50% scholarship quota</li> </ul> <p>is applied.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For students placed with <b>Full Scholarship</b> quota, an additional <b>dining scholarship</b> is given.</li> </ul> <p>The tuition fee for the children of the contract workers at <b>İstek Foundation Institutions</b> and <b>Yeditepe University</b> is half the announced amount. Scholarships at two different categories cannot be merged. <b>The higher amount applies.</b></p> <p>2016-2017 tuition fees can be paid through a <b>6-month</b> installment plan, provided <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> of the total amount is paid cash. Following an agreement with the bank, the payment dates for the installments should be November 5th 2016, December 5th 2016, February 5th 2017, March 5th 2017, April 5th 2017, and May 5th 2017.</p>

		<p>In the case of payment in <b>two equal installments</b> , ½ of the total amount will be paid during registration, and the remaining ½ will be paid on January 20th.</p> <p>Possible <b>annual raise</b> in the tuition fees is determined and limited to the previous year's Consumer Price Index (<b>TÜFE</b>).</p>
See 3	Scholarships	<p>Including the compulsory preparatory program, the given scholarships cover the following, and the student is required to pay the remaining amount: <b>Full Scholarship</b>: full amount of the tuition fee; <b>75% Scholarship</b>: two thirds of the tuition fee; <b>50% Scholarship</b>: half of the tuition fee, and <b>25% Scholarship</b>: one fourth of the tuition fee (excludes voluntary preparatory classes).</p>
See 63 cont.	All Programs	<p>Grants for students placed in <b>scholarship quota</b> are non-refundable and cover the educational expenses only. Scholarships involve the time period for compulsory Preparatory Language Programs, and continue throughout the departmental studies (9 terms for 4-year-programs; 11 terms for 5-year-programs; and 14 terms for 6-year-programs) regardless of the academic achievement of the student. An extra term is added for a scholarship student with a double major. Students who are placed with one of the following <b>YGS score</b> groups <b>MF, TS, TM</b>; and those who rank the following in the program they are placed, will be awarded the following amounts for the indicated time periods during their compulsory preparatory program and departmental studies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>first 100</b>, monthly <b>1 250,00 TL for 9 months</b></li> <li>• <b>first 500</b>, monthly <b>1 000,00 TL for 9 months</b></li> <li>• <b>first 1000</b>, monthly <b>750,00 TL for 9 months</b></li> <li>• <b>first 2000</b>, monthly <b>500,00 TL for 9 months</b> and</li> <li>• <b>first 5000</b>, monthly <b>300,00 TL for 9 months</b></li> </ul> <p>Students placed with <b>DİL-1</b> score and rank in the first 100 will receive a monthly payment of <b>500,00 TL for 9 months</b>.</p> <p>Among the students who are placed in their first five preferences with one of the following <b>YGS</b> groups <b>MF, TS, TM</b>; those who rank the first <b>15 000 (first 100 for DİL-1 students)</b> in the program they are placed will be awarded a <b>dining scholarship for 9 months</b>.</p> <p>In addition to the aforementioned financial support, students who rank in the <b>first 5 000 ( first 200 for DİL-1 students)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• benefit from <b>free accommodation</b> at a <b>double room</b> in university dorm or <b>free transportation</b></li> <li>• have <b>free access to the sports facilities at the social complexes of the university</b></li> </ul> <p>during their mandatory preparatory program and departmental studies.</p> <p>Students who are placed with one of the following <b>YGS</b> groups <b>MF, TS, TM</b>; and placed in any department ranking within <b>the first 15 000 ( for Faculty of Engineering the first 20 000)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• benefit from <b>free accommodation</b> at a <b>room shared by four</b> in university dorm or <b>free transportation</b></li> <li>• have <b>free access to the sports facilities at the social complexes of the university</b></li> </ul> <p>during their compulsory preparatory program and departmental studies.</p> <p>Provided they meet the requirements, students who are placed with one of the following <b>YGS</b> groups <b>MF, TS, TM</b>; and placed in any department ranking within <b>the first 15 000 ( first 200 for DİL-1 students)</b> are given priority to join the <b>international exchange programs</b> for one term in Canada and America (valid for the programs that the universities have mutual agreement).</p> <p>Students who graduate ranking <b>first, second, and third</b> in their departments receive <b>full scholarship, 50% scholarship, and 25% scholarship respectively</b> at the graduate programs of the university.</p> <p>Students placed at Yeditepe a University within their first five preferences might be given <b>25% discount</b> provided they meet the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>International Bachelorette (IB) grade 32 and higher,</b></li> </ul>

If there is no equivalent program at their current university, these students may demand (for only once) to be placed to a <b>Turkish-medium program</b> by <b>OSYM</b> provided that their score is not lower than the relevant year's base score.</p>

(ABD North Carolina-UNCW)</b></li> </ul>	<p>Business Administration (Eng.), a joint undergraduate program between Yeditepe University and North Carolina University (UNCW),USA ,is a total of 4 years excluding the preparatory program. The students complete the first two academic years at Yeditepe University, and the remaining two at UNCW. The tuition fees will be paid to the university the student studies during that term. See 63 for 2016-2017 Yeditepe University tuition fees. 2016-2017 tuition fees in UNCW (excluding summer school), is 21 000 USD, including the mandatory health insurance.
